## Implementation of the NQF-TT and Upcoming Training Programmes/Workshops

The Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago (ACTT) and the National Training Agency (NTA) wish to advise the general public of the commencement of implementation of the National Qualifications Framework for Trinidad and Tobago (NQF-TT).

The NQF-TT was approved by the Cabinet of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago in May, 2022. It is a ten-level Framework to which all qualifications – professional, academic and technical/vocational, both local and foreign – will be quality assured and mapped on a phased basis.

All stakeholders in education and training are advised to utilise the NQF-TT in the design and development of their programmes.
